Color: Crystal clear. When water is added it becomes pure white.

Flavor: Herby, star anise, sweet.

Grape variety: Grapes from the area of Tyrnavos

Distillation: In traditional copper pot-stills, with the presence of selected herbs

Served: With chilled water and/or on ice

Food pairing: “meze” for Ouzo and seafood. It is wonderful as aperitif.
